THE ACORN

Story Behind the Name

Born in The Side, just a short walk from our hotel, Admiral Lord Collingwood joined the Navy at the age of twelve and gave it his life. Wherever he went, it is said, he dropped acorns from his pocket so that in the future there would always be good oak trees to turn into battleships. In a brutal profession, he was a remarkable visionary, avoiding physical punishment for his men. As an admiral in 1805, he led the English fleet at the Battle of Trafalgar. Locals say that Collingwood, who has a street named after him just round the corner from our hotel, deserves as much credit for keeping the French and Spanish invasion at bay as Nelson.



THE BLAYDON BRICK

Story Behind the Name

Joseph Cowen was a 19th century entrepreneur, politician, publisher and philanthropist known locally as 'The Blaydon Brick', in tribute to his brickworks and his stocky build. Cowen was a one-man typhoon of activity, creating social housing and channelling his wealth into grand projects like the Tyne Theatre & Opera House, which was designed to be a 'Theatre for everyone'. As proprietor of the Newcastle Chronicle, he fought for the poorest members of society and turned the paper into 'The Times of the North'. As MP for Newcastle, he shocked his fellow parliamentarians at Westminster by refusing to tone down his Geordie accent to fit in.





MADAME ÉLÉPHANTE

Story Behind the Name

Our neighbourhood has always attracted one of a kind characters, including Harry Houdini, who famously dove off the Swing Bridge in 1913 with his hands tied. In 1733, a showman launched his donkey from Castle Keep's tower, equipped with strapped on wings. It miraculously survived the 100-foot drop. However, nothing beats a scene which unfolded at the original Theatre Royal in 1830 when an elephant named Mademoiselle D'Jeck was tried for murder. On her way to Newcastle from Edinburgh, her keeper gave her alcohol and she ended up trampling him to death. In a bizarre mix of justice and showbiz razzamatazz, D'Jeck was put on trial: she got off with a five-shilling fine!

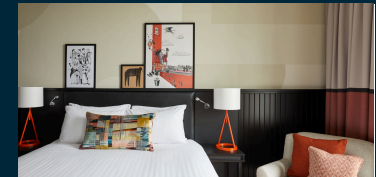

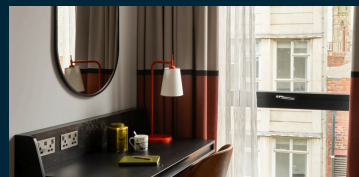
